

MONTHLY EXTENDED COVID-19 LEARNING PLANS (“ECLP”) ACTIONS

River Heights Academy (the “Academy”)

A special meeting of the Academy Board of Directors was held on the 22nd day of February 2021, at 5:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m. by Board Member Alex Garnepudi :

Prior to review and board action, the Academy Board, as required, solicited public comment from parents or legal guardians of the pupils enrolled at the Academy with regard to its ECLP. The following preamble and resolution were offered by Board Member Danielle Vining and supported by Board Member Kari Pardoe :

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to extended COVID-19 learning plan (“ECLP”) legislation, “[t]hirty days after the approval of the plan ... , and every 30 days thereafter, ... at a meeting of the board or board of directors, ...” the Academy Board is required to take specific actions with regard to how instruction is going to be delivered during the 2020-2021 school year, solicit public comment, and publicly announce weekly interaction rates.

THE ACADEMY BOARD THEREFORE RESOLVES THAT:

1. The Academy Board is reconfirming that instruction shall be delivered as follows during the 2020-2021 school year:

Learning Plan: Kindergarten - 8th grades will continue with Remote Learning for all students until April 9th, 2021.

Modification:

Community Care: River Heights Academy (RHA) will reopen the Community Care option on Monday, February 8, 2021 to provide students a safe, warm place to participate in remote learning with internet access and meals. Health and safety mitigation efforts will be implemented. Interested families completed an application to participate in the Community Care option.

In-Person Option: RHA team is planning to launch an in-person option for families beginning on April 12, 2021. Family option and voice is core to the RHA model. For this reason, each family will be asked to complete a survey selecting an in-person or remote option for their child in February. Families selecting in-person will attend RHA on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday with all health and safety mitigation efforts in place. All students will be remote on Wednesdays. In the event that RHA is not able to safely accommodate all requests for in-person learning, alternate models will be explored (e.g., 2 days a week in person or ½ day in-person). RHA is committed to providing an opportunity for in-person instruction for all interested families.

In-person Pilot: RHA teachers will have an option to participate in an in-person learning pilot from February 15th - March 19th, 2021. Interested teachers will provide instruction to remote students at home and students who are in-person at the same time. They will be responsible for testing a variety of instructional practices,

Defined as the percentage of students enrolled in the Academy that have two (2) two-way interactions with the student’s teacher or one of the student’s teacher. The Academy shall ensure that 2 two-way interactions occur between a student enrolled in the Academy and the student’s teacher or at least one of the student’s teachers during each week of the school year for at least 75% of pupils enrolled in the district.

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tools, and exploring the model in real-time. The pilot opportunity ensures a strong transition to the model prior to fully launching with all students in April.


2. The Academy Board, during this meeting, solicited public comment from the parents or legal guardians of the pupils enrolled in the Academy.
